GUIDED VISIT

La Vallée des Saints, a unique site in the heart of Brittany

To visit la Vallée des Saints is to unveil a glimpse into Brittanys history, get a close up perspective of art, and travel through a world of amazing legends and ancient rituals.

On a natural site at an altitude of 230m above sea level, offering a panoramic view of Central Brittany, la Vallée des Saints invites you to discover monumental statues, on average 4m tall, representing Breton saints.

The Breton saints thus honoured, are mostly monks and scholars from Great Britain and Ireland. They evangelized Armorica in the early Middle Ages, leaving an important and varied heritage which is still very much present in Brittany and Great Britain today.

- ▶ 184 monumental statues in situ on the site
- → 3 sculpting sessions which can be viewed by the public: 15 new statues

OPTION 1: GUIDED VISIT - 1H



Guide's advice: we recommend you allow extra free time (approx. 1 hour) to explore the entire site (16 acres), observe the sculptors at work when they are present, visit our boutique and discover Saint Gildas chapel.

Firstly, your guide explains what la Vallée des Saints is about, why and how monumental statues are erected each year and who the Breton personalities represented are. Your group will be able to comprehend our site, which has been occupied by mankind for thousands of years, from prehistory to the Middle Ages, with the remains of a feudal mound still present.

A large part of your visit will be devoted to discovering several statues and their mysterious attributes.

The guide will recount some Breton legends. For example: How did Saint Paol-Aurelian save the inhabitants of Batz Island from a terrible dragon? How did Saint Tenenan cure leprosy instantly? Many questions will be answered to afford you a deeper understanding.

OPTION 2: GUIDED VISIT 45MIN + QUIZ 1H



Guide's advice: for Work Committee-type groups, company seminars, and for those who wish to organise an interactive, fun and friendly outing, combining cultural discovery and games.

The activity begins with a 45-min guided visit that allows for everyone to be able to ask questions.

Afterwards, the participants will be divided into several groups. Which team will then be the fastest to solve the puzzles in quiz?
